Fall is Bulb Time – Tulips, That Is

Plant tulip bulbs in flower boxes this Fall. They can give your patio, deck or porch a colorful Spring look. Tulip bulbs can be planted in many types of flower boxes as long as there is good drainage and they are deep enough, such as the Countryside 12"x27" patio planter. Choose from hunter green, terra, adobe or white.



You can plant the bulbs closer together than you usually would in the garden. You can even plant the bulbs in two layers so that the flowering period is considerably extended by using two different varieties. Water them regularly and remove wilted flowers.

To protect the tulip bulbs against severe frost in winter, cover the flower boxes or move them to a frost-free area, but not to a heated location where temperatures rise over 55 degrees F.
